

Psychology Intern/Extern Curriculum:

The Pediatric Mood Disorders Clinic has opportunities for doctoral students in clinical psychology looking for a practicum experience, as well as for interns in the APA-approved psychology internship program as an elective rotation. Opportunities include:

- Caseload of approximately 4-6 patients (depending on time commitment), including child, adolescent, and family cases, with opportunities for individual and family work
- Participation (observation or co-leadership) in group therapy programs, *RAINBOW* for children with bipolar disorder, and *Hidden Treasures* for children with depression
- Weekly team meetings that include case conference, journal club, discussions about research and clinical issues
- Directed reading in childhood mood disorders literature
- Weekly supervision with licensed clinical psychologist specializing in childhood mood disorders
- Opportunities for involvement in various research projects in PIRAMD (see website)
